The Vermont Monitoring Cooperative (VMC) will hold its 14th Annual Meeting at the University of Vermont on Monday, October 30th, from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm in the North Lounge room of the Billings Center building, located on University Place at UVM in Burlington, VT.

The VMC Annual Meeting is an opportunity for the public, scientists, students, and natural resource professions to learn about novel forest health research projects, share information, and network for collaboration.
