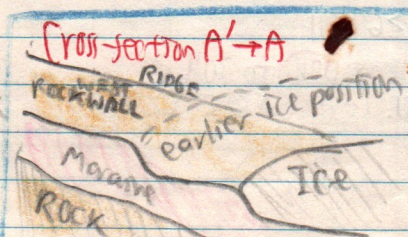
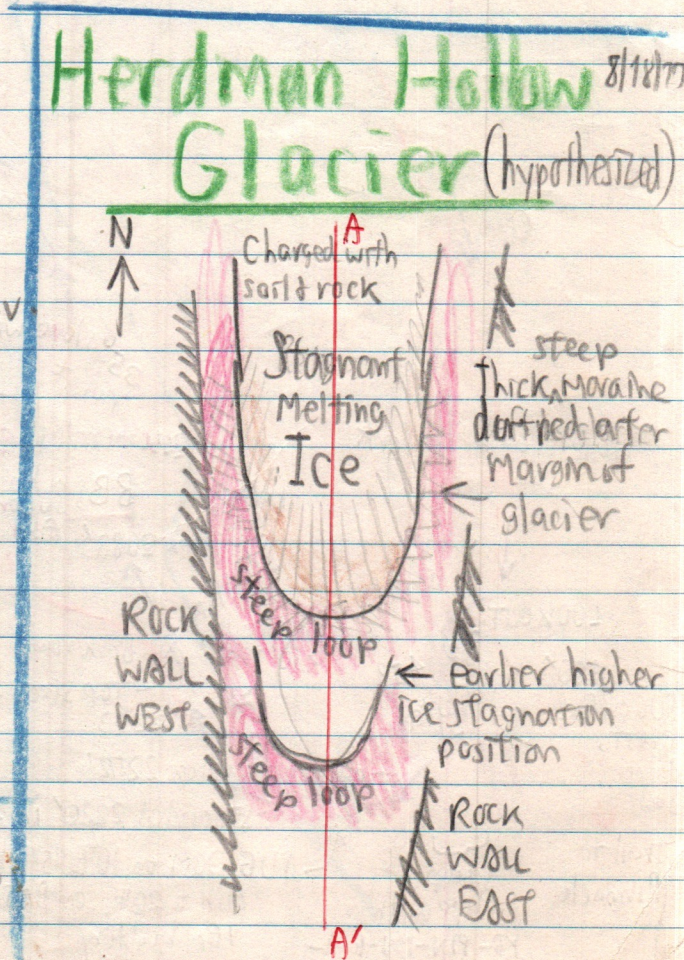
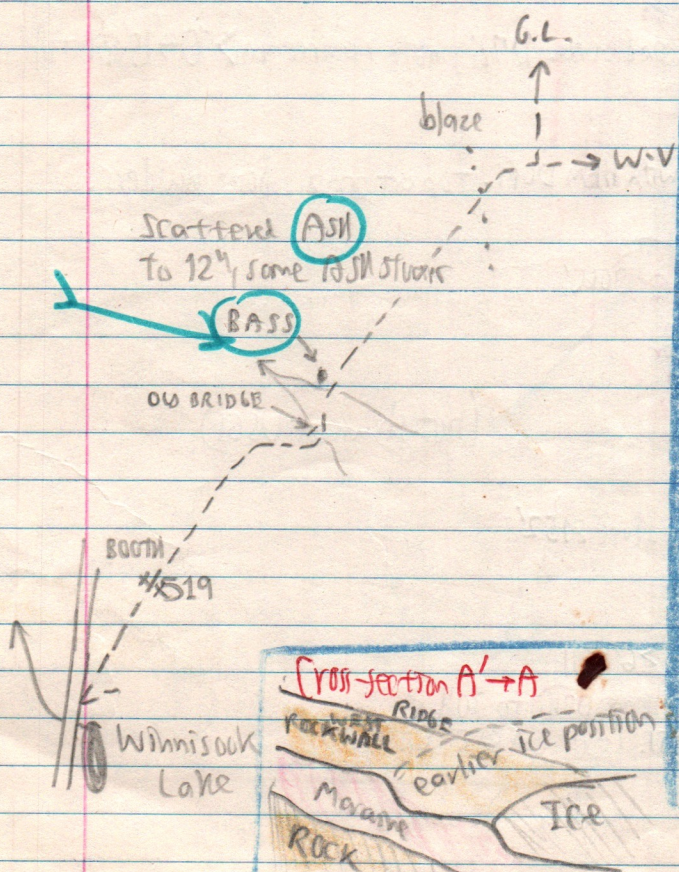


Panther Mtn. - Giant Ledge

 - 1936: Fox Hollow lean to built, 1936. (P44).

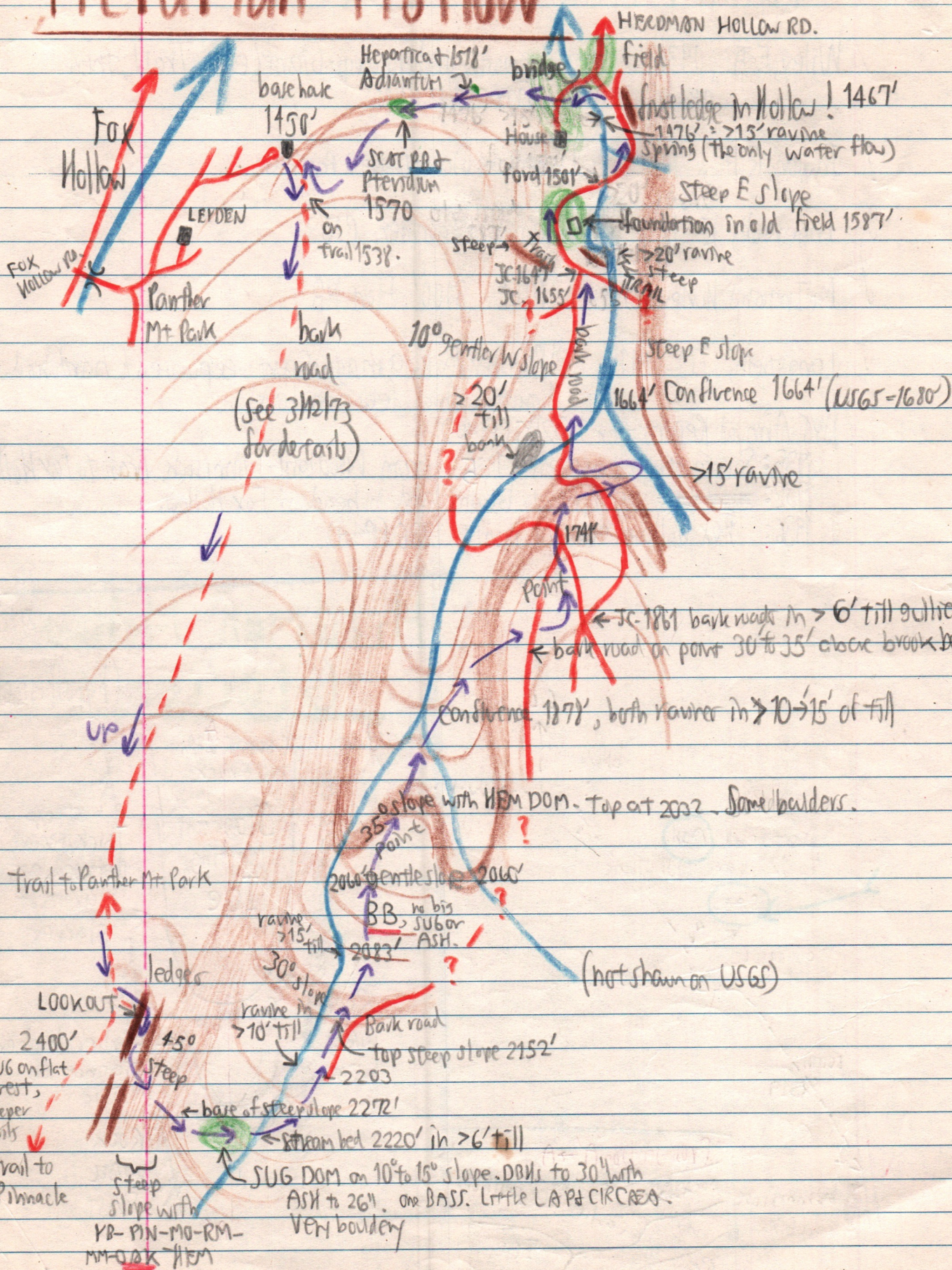
