

Eagle - Haynes 6/10/83 Additional Commentary 220-17A

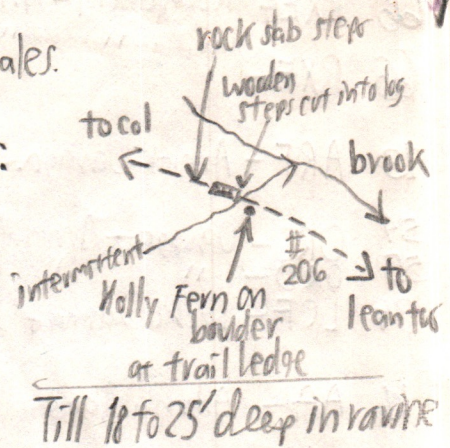
Late spring (compare with ADK data):

Eagle summit - still in flower: VA, CLAVT, MC in fl. bud

YB&RM in 1/3 to 1/2 leaf, BC stragles dropping & bud scales.

Butternut near trail base only in 1/2 to 3/4 leaf.

Polystichum braunii - One small plant on McKinley Hollow trail:

Haynes S shoulder, open area: PIN in fl.

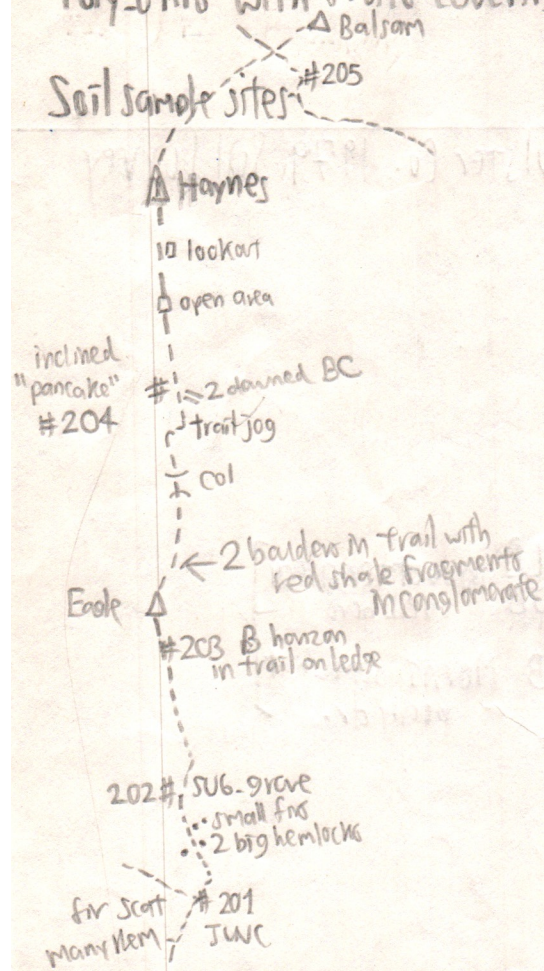
~~Few "pancakes" occur in Catskills because large slab horizontal channels held the root systems down; dead trees tend to snap off their stumps instead. (recoiled)~~

Dense fir repro. on Eagle just N of summit on W side of trail.

Just N of this a 25' tall fir lightning struck with a portion of its trunk scattered on trail.

Poly-Ohio with fruits covering boulders look like porcupines!
