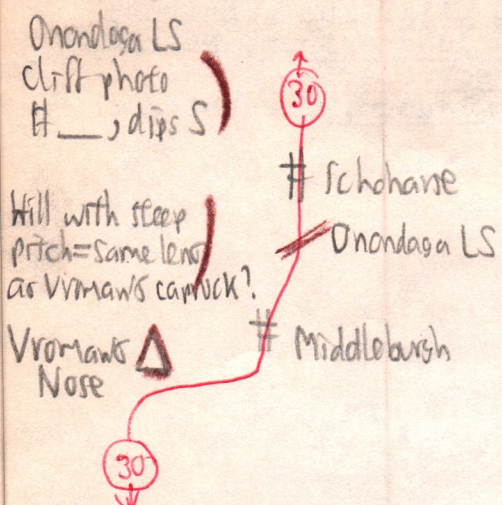
Vegetation

Larva ovata with narrow leaflets. [R. then a photo?]

Leucodryum

Dicranum scoparium?

Gray fruticose lichens.



Till cobbles on Vroman's Nose:

- LS with brachiopods
- Gneiss common [AOKS?]
- Black shale
- Gray S-S.

Geology & Soil

Striae on ledge to SW on ^{senke} sandy black shale.
Till 2 ft thick above.
Road on ledge on ascent.
Till yellow ochre ^{below} but reddish above.
Windthrow mounds 2 ft high.

Kern dom. on N slope under oak

On descent of steep S slope.

Anemone(?) with 5 white sepals, 7 cm across. What of lvs. 6 or 7, compound.

Red oak with very variable lvs
Nepenthes is round-lobed

Foxglove(?)

Hypoxis fragile on a shale slope

Ascent road up

Ascent made on old log rd from back, or NW, side.

Pass gate.

ledge, low with Cyst. frag.

Barbed wire fence.

Road bends; trail to W

Enter woods

Cabin site

Summit

Follow old wire fence down
