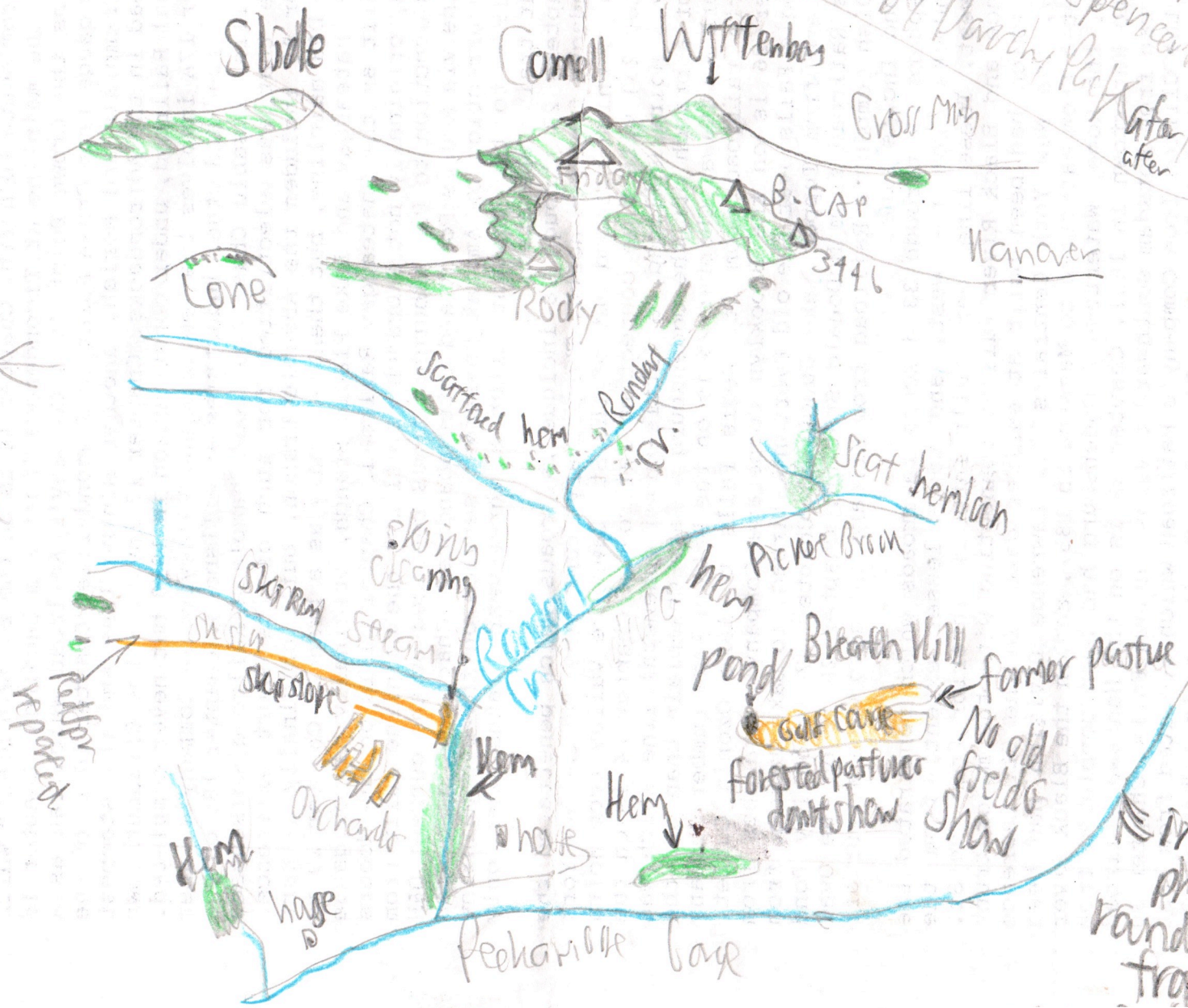

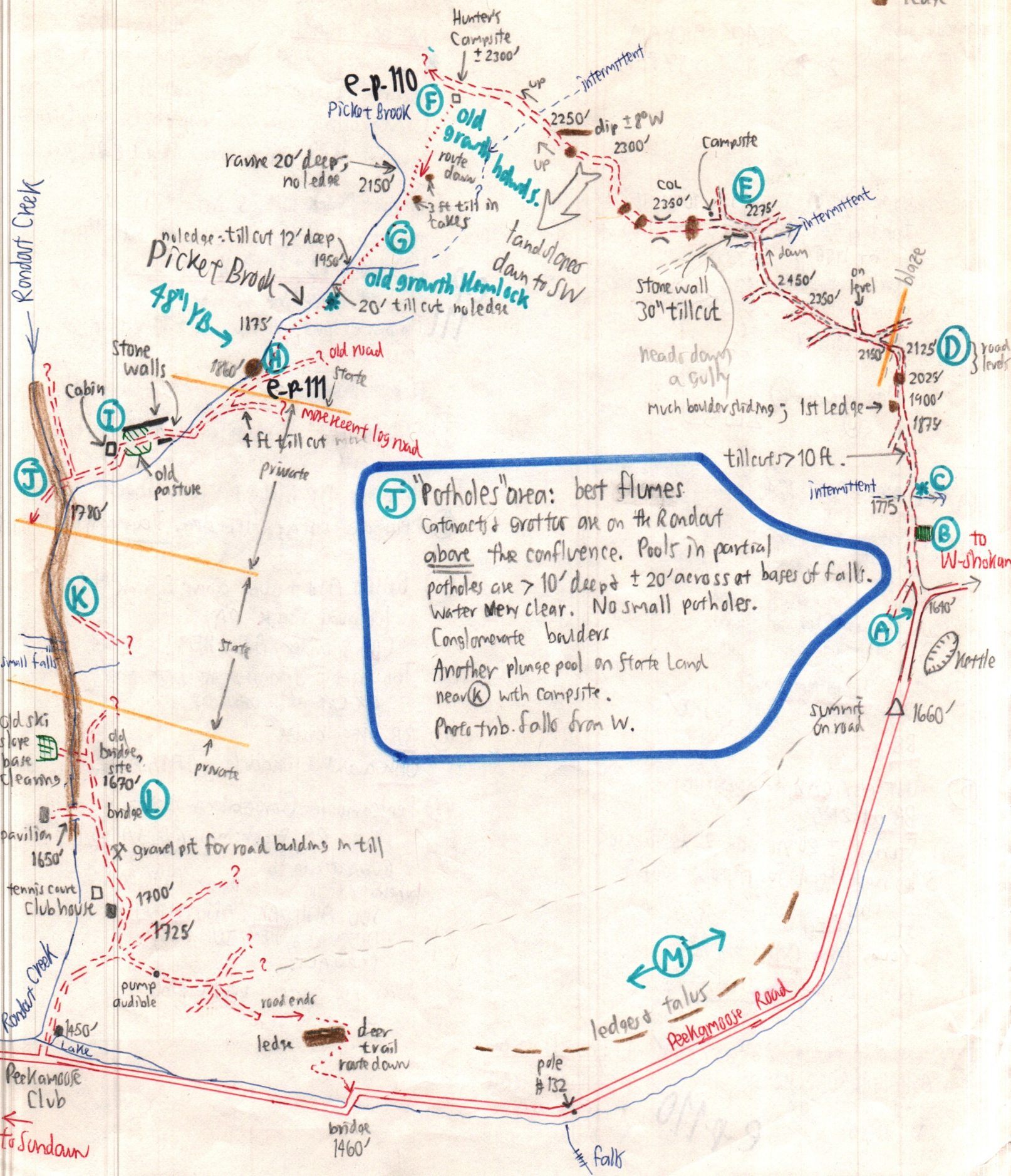

 Catawacts & grotto are on the Rondout  
above the confluence. Pools in partial  
 potholes are > 10' deep & ± 20' across at bases of falls.  
 Water very clear. No small potholes.  
 Conglomerate boulders  
 Another plunge pool on State Land  
 near **K** with campsite.  
 Photo tub. falls from W.

Lunch; State Land 1:14

- (A) OAK + BASS 1640'
- (B) Clearing = Hamam at edge Vitis, Europeans, ±1750' Stashom Sumac, good view of Chestnut burn (1982?) on High Point.
- (C) ±24" Tulip tree, initially mistaken for a BASS. ±1800' BB
- (D) OST. ASH, OAK, LEUCOBRYUM BB at 2140'
- (E) Stumps ±20 yrs old. 2275' to 2350' 3 log roads head SW onto Beech Hill Stone wall Ed of col. Young Hem. OAK, big BCs. ASH, BC to 30", Ilex mont, Hamam

- (F) Hems and YB to 36". 2300' ASH, B, SUB, BC, HAMAM BASS at 2250' ASH to 36" SUB to 30" } possibly never logged despite roads above & below

- (F) continued = 2 SUBs down with pancake 30" deep but 12' x 24' across.
- (G) Hemlock grove = trees to 36" with OX + \$ No back roads. 2050 to 1875 \* take with weak E horizon (collected) + Bs beneath. Distinctly a Spodosol in Hem-grove. Grove follows narrow ridge between Pickett Brook + 1875' tributary. RM @ dom.
- (H) Pickett Brook cut 25' into till. Very stony baldern terrace above with Hem, YB + OX. YB ±48" DBH photos. ASH at blaze line nearby. 1850' On private land, stumps 20 to 30 yrs old. PIN Pickett Brook has flood ridges + channels
- (I) Old pasture = stone wall on N 5 ft high could have held in domesticated animals. Hamam, DP in old pasture. Shack
- (J) "Potholes" area: Hem dom, Ilex mont, YB, RM, B
- (K) BASS + ASH + SUB above E bank ±1950', 100' above Creek, PA, CB + \$ under ASH + HEM! Trib from E springs: Brachythecum / Bryhnia - OX-LAP-ARTIF DENT DI.
- (L) BB near bridge OAK around Clubhouse, BASS, ASH 1725'
- (M) Peekamoose Gorge along road: YB, MM, RM, Stashom, SORB, SAMB, HAMAM Rubus odor in fl. When gorge is wider near falls on S: SUG, ASH, OAK, BASS, POLEN IVY DIERVILLA, HEM, JUGLANS, CORN ALT. Summit of gorge: White pine
