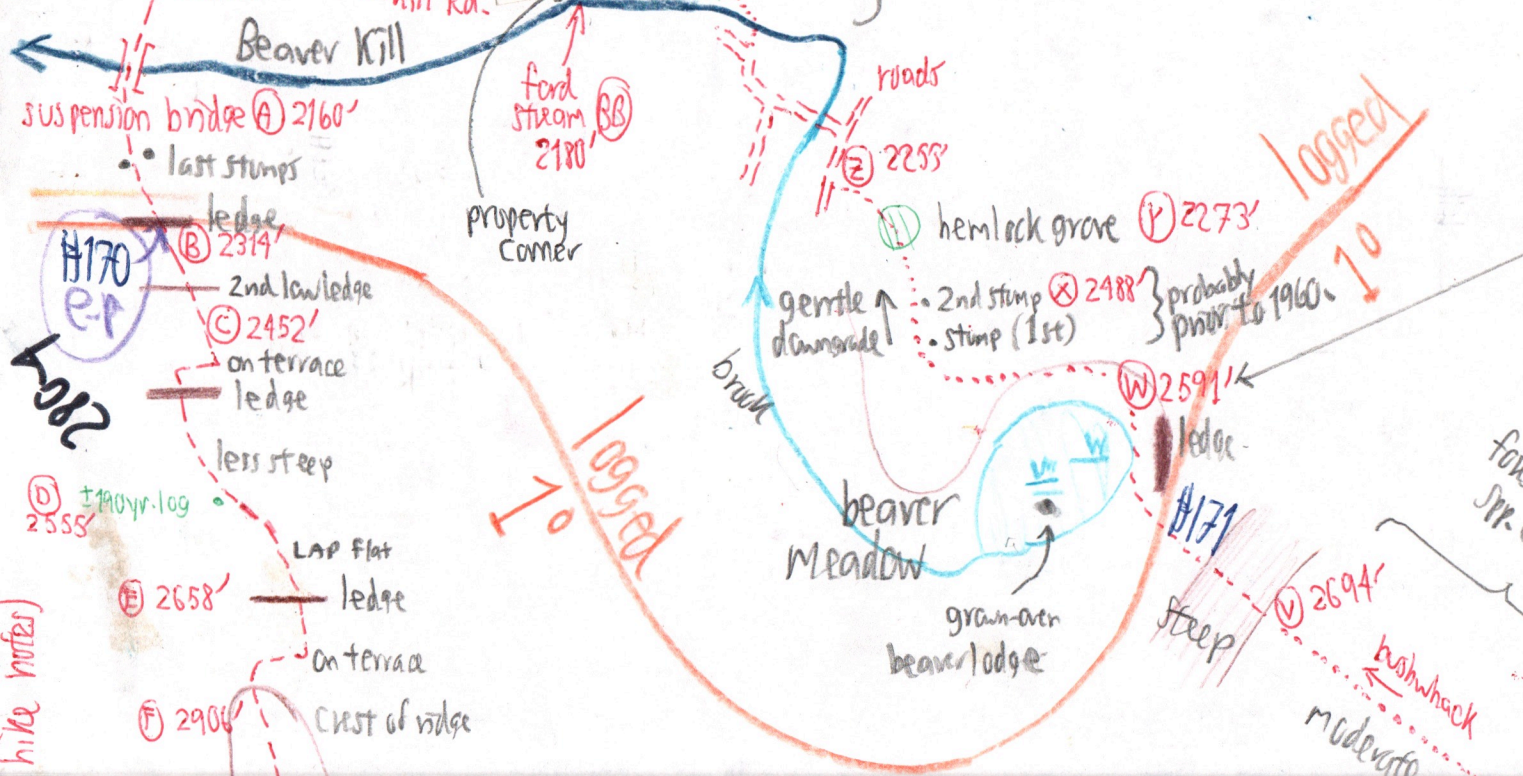

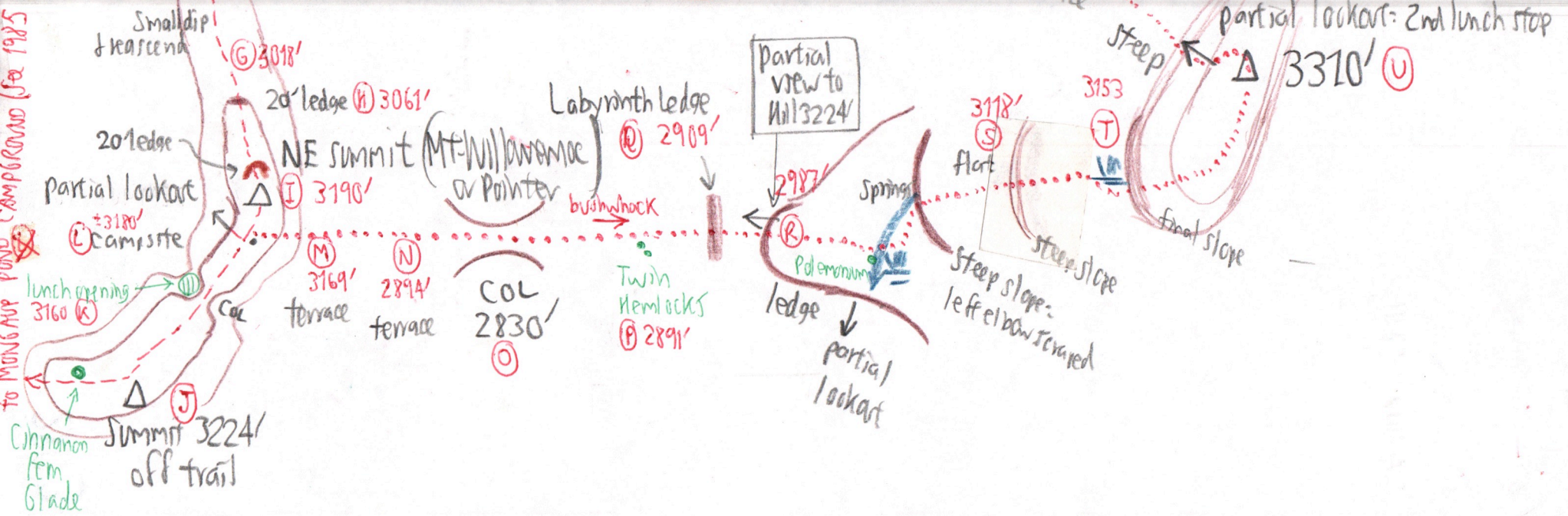

# Soil Depth

- (F) 1st shallow; SUB out temp (any)
- (H) 3061' on ridge = 18 to 24" in cake
- (G) >24" in 2 cakes

The terraces from (R) to (T) have NO SUB on the outer ledge top ends, but SUB does occur on the inner slope bases where there is a spring or swamp. Outer ends dom by B + BC.
