1936'

(D) Seep with BASS + abun.  
2171' Alliaria (see also at (AA))

(E) 13" Chestnut, observed with  
2261' Chris Olney in 2000, 6/23 (SS)  
now dead, but sprouting. (P. 50)  
Photo with Amillanella

(H) Chickshanks may not  
2460' have cut, or cutlers, the  
1890s, <sup>established</sup> OAK + ASH than  
Crossroads Ventures.

On Chickshank Land,  
blue blazes mark trees  
to be cut. Oak seedlings

(K) More B + BC (L) on slope  
2749' forest transitions to  
to 2830' ridge forest (M) More YB

(O) Follow ASH-OAK upper  
2749' limits, 2° below to E  
and 1° above to west.  
Line begins to curve off  
to west as we descend  
in 2°. This 1° banding  
needs to be followed  
in the future over to  
the Belleaire-Balsam  
col. Gentle terrace  
at (O) 2 BCs 25" ±  
on west.

(P) Bigtooth, 7 in a  
2699' grove, to 12".  
NO ASH + NO OAK  
locally.

(Q) Steep. Beech  
2527' thickets. NEM grave  
visible to S + SW across  
the ravine at (H) ← green!!  
the highest in Last Clare

(R) Same OAK + OST.  
2484' 1st NEMLOCK on descent;  
this single tree shows  
up on Alan's aerial  
photo. A few more  
below on east.

Alan calls localities  
with known histories  
which can be compared  
with similar localities of  
unknown histories.

REFERENCE SITES

(S) Steep + rocky, but NO  
2269' ledge exposed. OAK  
common. Approach SMY  
blaze Chickshank  
OAK seeds abun.

(T) Landslip from seep on  
2119' steep stream bank.  
40 to 50' ravine in till  
with a ledge.

Intermediate woodfern,  
Si, abun on S side of  
ravine but rarer on N.  
ASH - Largest NEM  
observed, scattered,  
to 30" ±.

(X) Photo of beech with  
1866 spiral bark.  
Cross tributary about  
25' above main stream  
BB-NEM-PM.  
Largest NEM 22.3" dbh  
One NEM "cane" 36" ±  
deep in soil.

(V) NEM understory.  
1918 Two 14" OST.  
YB stumps  
Possible back road  
up to SE.

(Z) Out of hemlock under-  
1981 story. SUG-BASS-  
ASH. Skid roads  
with 1960s stumps.

(AA) Alliaria abun in  
1950 seep at head of ravine.  
See also at (D) where  
it has also invaded.

(BB) Hemlocks on ledges  
7950' whether large nor old -  
(FE) Old pasture, wooded  
1603 at NW end, more open  
at SE end.

Wood sample from dunned  
log somewhere around (O)  
or (P) = Chestnut?
