General Comments.

The low entry point
(#287) elevation at
2478 ft, barely 150 ft
above the creek, reflects
the ledgy, talus slope
nearly continuous from
(I) down to (S). Only the
fence at (M) breaks the
slope. SUB is
uncommon above (O) 2688',
reminiscent of the N
slope of Lone Mtn.
