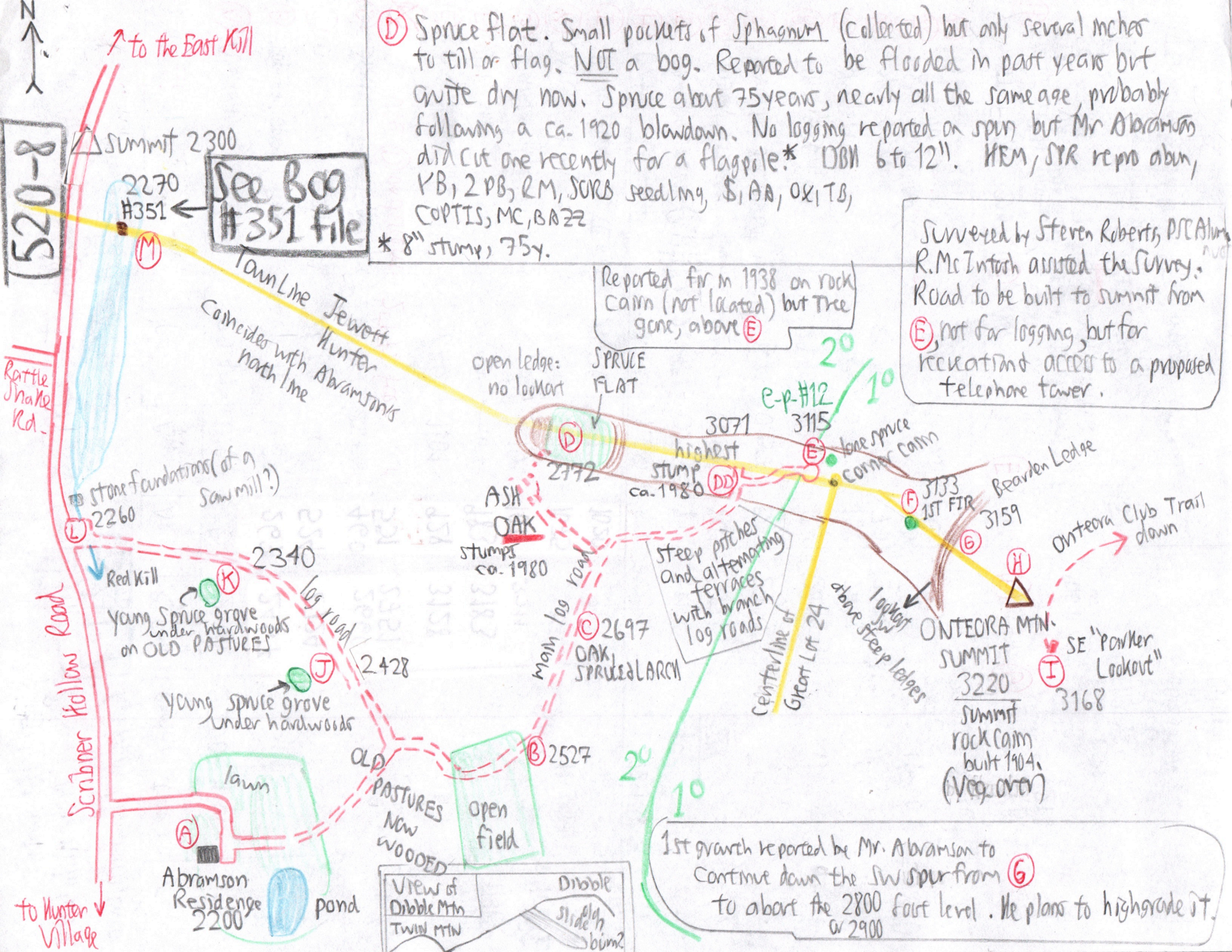

(D) Spruce flat. Small pockets of Sphagnum (collected) but only several inches to till or flag. NOT a bog. Reported to be flooded in past years but quite dry now. Spruce about 75 years, nearly all the same age, probably following a ca. 1920 blowdown. No logging reported on spur but Mr Abramson did cut one recently for a flagpole.* DBH 6 to 12". HEM, SPR repro abun, YB, 2 PB, RM, SURB seedling, S, AA, OK, TB, COPTIS, MC, BA?? * 8" stump, 75y.

Surveyed by Steven Roberts, PSC Alum. R. McIntosh assisted the Survey. Road to be built to summit from (E), not for logging, but for recreation and access to a proposed telephone tower.

Reported fire in 1938 on rock cairn (not located) but tree gone, above (E)
