

Mill Brook Ridge soil stoniness ^{5/20/03}

NW edge of summit crest along trail. Some D.M. removed by campers, exposing mineral soil.

Ten readings using 100 cm on folding ruler =

10, 24, 25, 34, 40, 60, 60, 65, 69, 70 Median: **50**

Ten more readings along trail as it begins to descend to the W, open stably area, but dominant is BC with scattered KB.

13, 30, 34, 39, 40, 40, 48, 50, 75, 75 = Median: **40**

These ten are consecutive along the trail, the ruler placed Beech windthrow freshly fallen below = 50. end-to-end

Sugar maple sites from several different exposures along trail below Leanto (Beaver Meadow):

14, 14, 16, 18, 18, 25, 26, 27, 28, 50. Median **22**
