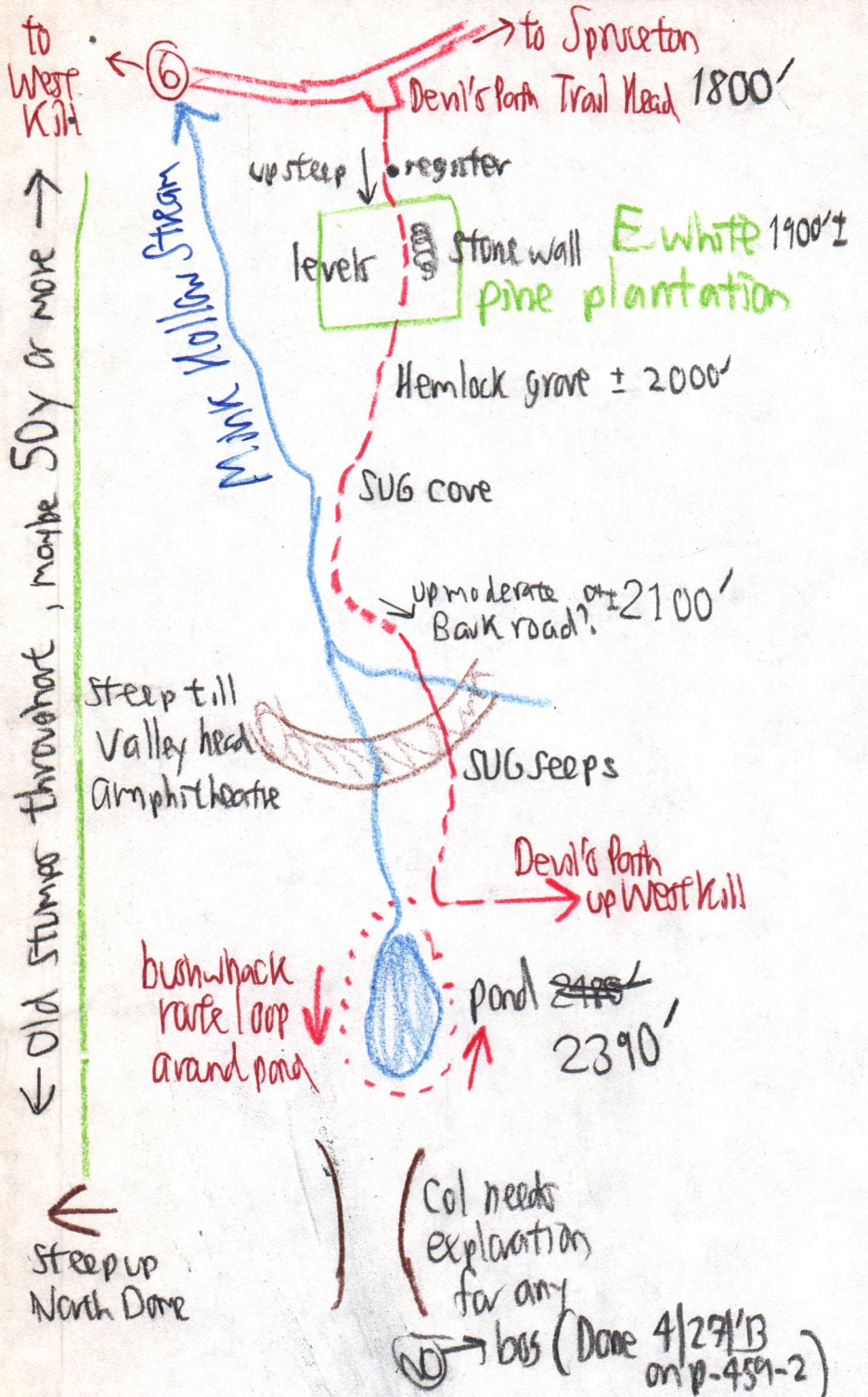

West Kill - North Dome Col Pond

The pond is ± 300 ft long x 100 to 120 ft wide with at least a foot of standing water. Boulders abundant throughout. NO evidence of beaver activity in recent times - no beaver-chewed stumps or dam, but could have been at one time.

Carex stricta (?) dam - COLL
Drosera abundant
 ELM - RM - YB - Several younger
 KEM - AMEL
 ASH on W edge GR pink white, but need checking to disprove black.

BASSWOOD on edge
 HAMAM IMP/LAP
 ASTER PUN, LYCOPUS,
 LYSIMACHIA TEER,
 RUBUS PUB (NOT KISSP)
Mattercia at South end.
 R TRISTE + RLAC

Natural till dam, no ledge.

Fernalis (?) giant moss in arlet

Anemone ranunculifolia along Devil's Path up West Kill from Red House (W Kill) Falls under SUG at ± 2800', in immature fruit. Is this the East-most station? Abundant in head of Beaverkill.
