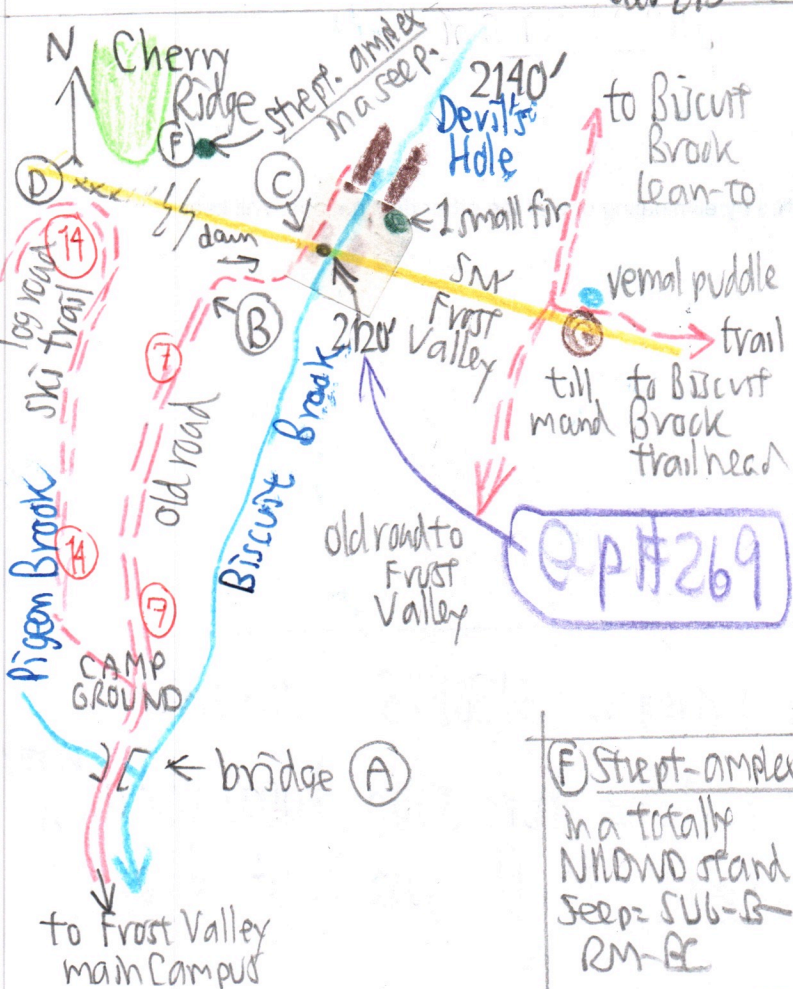

- (A) bridge built 1909 by John Coddington Co.
- (B) Ski trail #7 follows an old road to here with NEM too few for banking. Prob an old log road. Road ends abruptly. Ski/foot narrow trail turns sharply right & steeply down amid boulders, approaching the brook. This is a new ENTRY POINT, #269, about 300 ft from the gorge.
- (C) Photo of PB roots exposed + photo of hemlock with Forstmann's deer fence scars.
- (D) More photos of deer fence atop Cherry Ridge crest.

Botanists along on Cherry Ridge hike, identified:

- Anemone
- Viola cucubita ^{flata}? with fls held high above leaves
- V-macklousyei
