

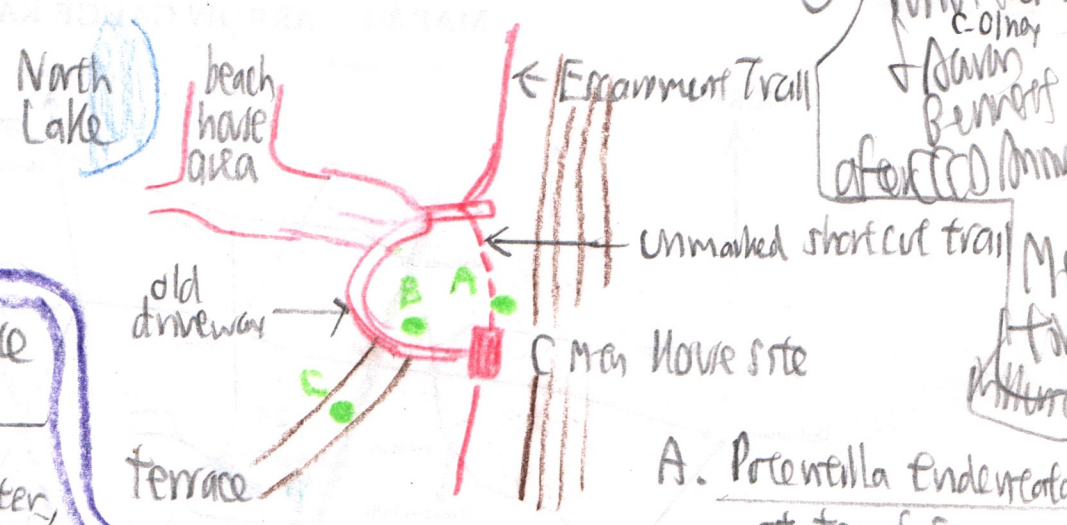

MTNS Bartrams' hike  
5/11/14

(A) Large overhangy rock shelter, probably camped in by Bartrams in 1753. Conglomerate over sandstone.

(E) Fern found on ledge below: prob. Woodsia ilvensis; Viola serotina, not cuc., reported, not obs.

(D) Chimaphila umbellata

(H) Epigaea + Gaultheria proc.

+ Woods mixed with ewh + pitch pines, HEM, OAK. Beneath MC, TB, AN, as in Del. Co. aban. pastures.

(B) 1 fir on wet terrace. + 3 above the ledge.

(K) foundation stone corner, possibly a garage or stable?

(I) Fir sapling off trail, <sup>but</sup> visible.

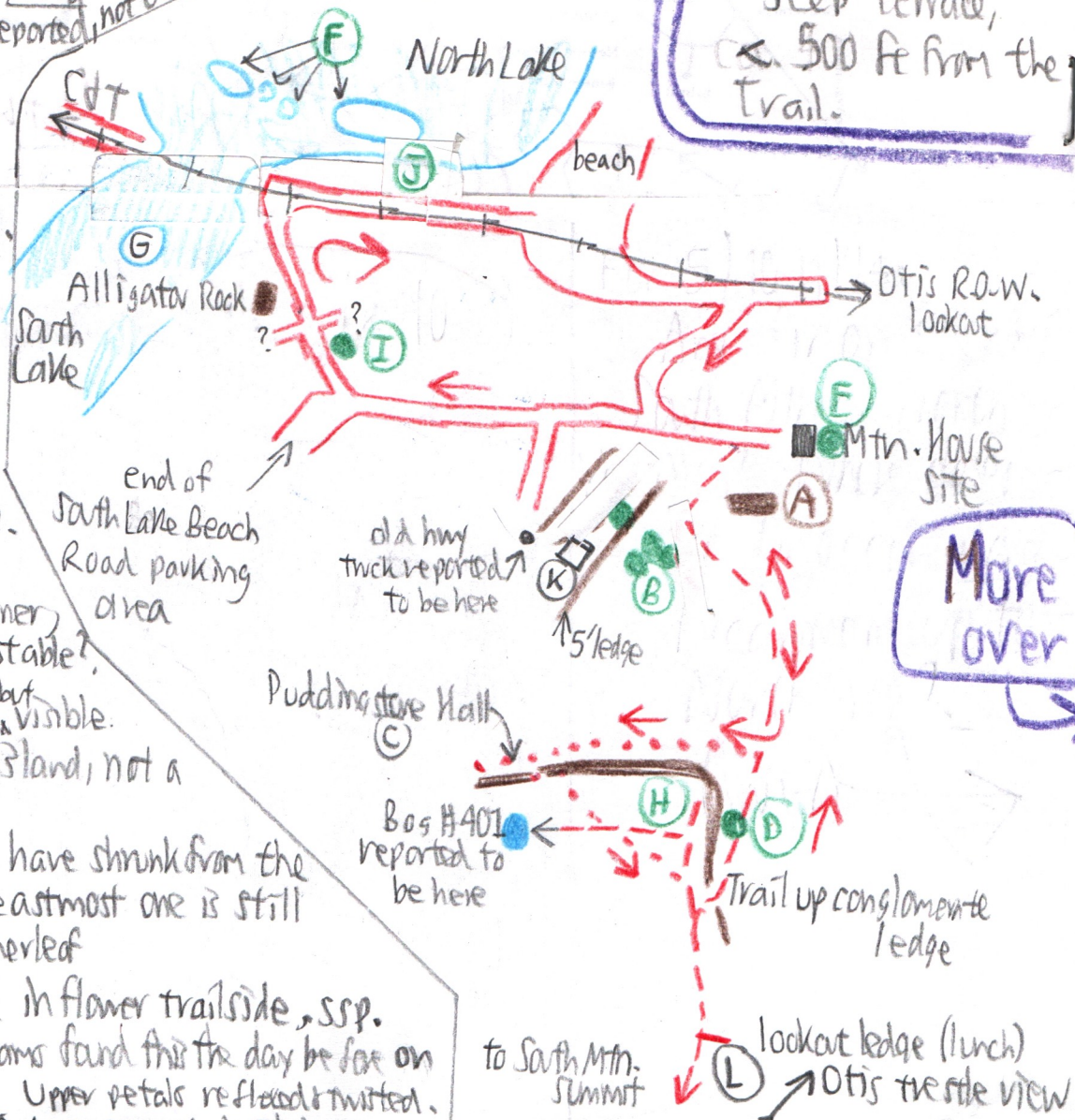
(G) Man-made mineral island, not a floating mat.

(F) The 3 west islands have shrunk from the 1990s, but the eastmost one is still large with leatherleaf

(J) Viola macloskeyi in flower trailside, ssp. pallens. Sam Adams found this the day he set on Diamond Notch trail. Upper petals reflexed & twisted. Lvs crenate & glabrous.

B. Pitch pine  
C. Several firs on a steep terrace, < 500 ft from the trail.
