- (B) 21B' Near leanto: IMP pallidus Rudbeckia in flower.
- (C) to (D) defoliated in June, lvs 1/2 grown See (V).
- (E) ASH common; NEM repro., NO mature NEM.
- (F) more ASH abun. to 24" dbh. LAP abun. VC in flower at end of July
- (H) Two closely-parallel roads suggest older one eroded at & was replaced by new one. Not much hemlock here to have been a bark road earlier?

between 550 60 mgs, broken off 7 to 8 years up. \therefore planted about 65y ago, ca-1941. 1945 USGS Seager Quad shows open pasture when they were ca-4y old. A few naturalized repros. One big tooth down near W end, \uparrow mature dates prob to field aban. 1930s?

NO roads above farm.

(I)(J)(K)(L) Like Brown Farm, according to Laurie. Must have been mainly pasture because site is not good for crops. Seep spring provided water supply. Bldg. alongside. Not much water at all now. IMP abun.

(M)(N) last ash. (e-p # 511, ca 2850') definitely 10. Sibs to 30", Adiantum, Botrychium. DO YB's plate at beginning as trust cracks?

Norway spruce freshly fallen with needles on green shows \uparrow still

(P) Top of YB talus. Ground cover more boreal: CB, OK, AA, RG, LL, Hylacomium, Ptilium. Gentler slope above. Canopy 50'. More BC. (CONTINUED)

(R) to (U) BC dom on crest, B, RM, YB, MO, a few scat SUB, OX, MC, AN, RS, Cinn, AA, \$camryl, Stropt.

1 OAK at (S), but several on S side of crest ^{only} in shallow col SE of (T), still in 10. Not far below is blaze (not obs) with OAK-disturbed forest; see p. 221-9 from 1997 hike.

30" & 24" SUBS by cubic 3' rock near (S) (Laurie recognized this rock) BCs to 26".

(UU) 2903' YB (on talus 10' ledges) to 28"±, MM, Lonicem common.

(V) 2843' SUB dom, soil deeper, slopes less steep. Defoliated in June by forest tent caterpillars. See (C) to (D). One Saddled prominent larva obs on SUB bank.

(W) 2712' Less steep again below another, but less steep pitch. Big YB above this point, big SUB below to 30". ASH seedlings suggest ASH popln is climbing the slope ahead of parents.

(X) 2590' 30" ASH, 2nd big ASH, 40" SUB. Imp pallida s-ex. This is e-p # 512. VROT, ADIV.

NO CC (=Cornus canadensis) on this and many other C's ridges. Note where it DOES occur. Is it as boreal as CB?

Pcili, VA, DP, CMC, RB

(Y) 2543' Only a few scat. big SUB remain ahead, plus more ash, - most stems < 12" and young. Maybe once a sugarbush.

(Z) 2336' BASS. 20" NEM plus 2 broken 30" ^(AA) hemlocks among continuous NEM understory ²²⁹⁹ 20 to 30' tall.

(BB) 2280' Top of steep ledge dom by NEM to 24". Nil ground cover.

(CC) 2233' SNK blaze prob here but none of us obs it. Stumps. Log road.

(DD) 2113' 2nd log road. 25' deep ravine in till to east, nearly dry.

(EE) 1952' Clearing with camper-trailer at ravine base.
