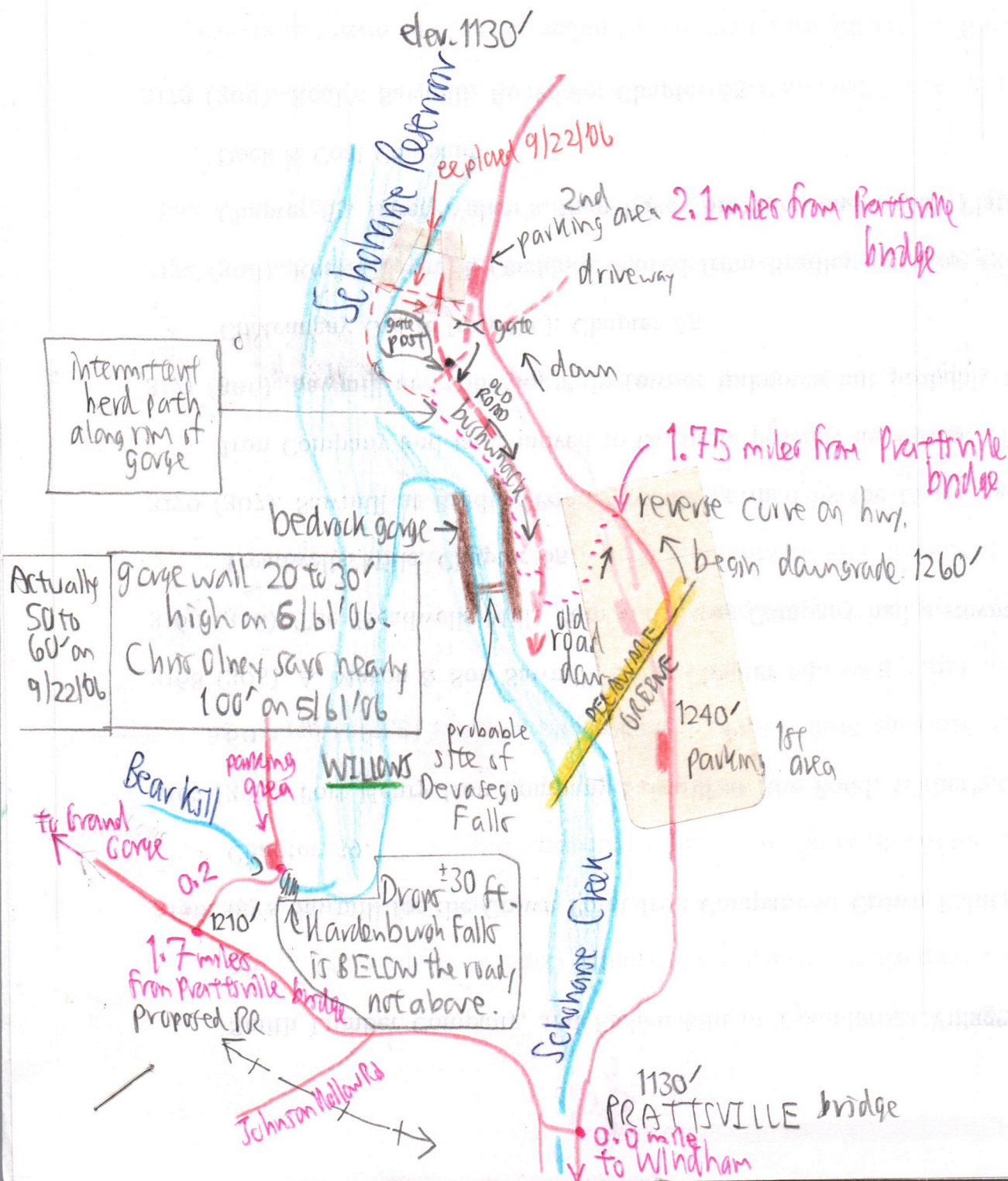


Devasego Falls area 425-1 6/6/06

Chris Olney, on 5/6/06, reported that Schoharé Reservoir had been drained so that reconstruction could begin on the Gilboa Dam; Devasego Falls was exposed. By 6/6/06, the reservoir level had risen to cover the falls & MK missed the opportunity to photograph them.



The whole area around Devasego falls is almost completely debilitated, mainly by forest tent caterpillars. Northern red oak & Black locust dominant. A few Chestnut oak & white oak leaves
