

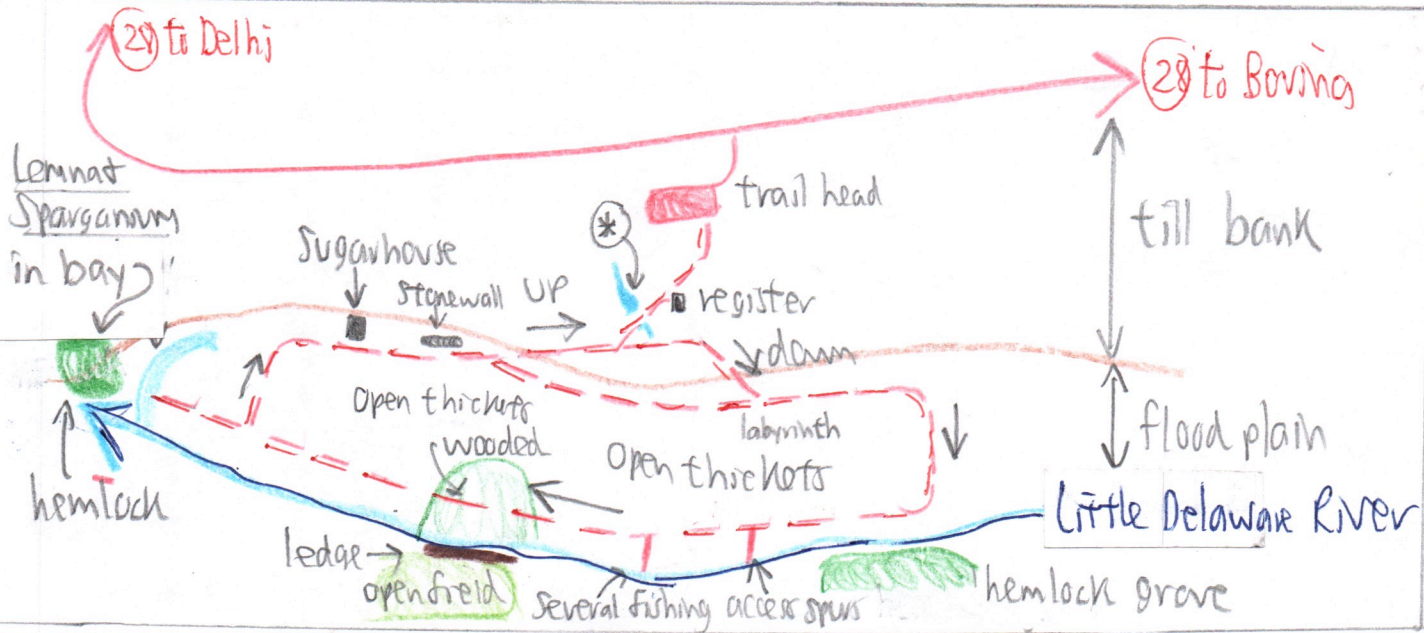
# Little Delaware River

412-1

SUNK Delhi field station, ~2 miles SE of Delhi

1st visit briefly 7/29/07 on return from Meredith Bog

Revisited 10/3/07 on return from Oneonta, about a 40-minute loop



Resembles strongly the flood plain of the East Branch at Kelly Corners + Halesville

### Rosa

either a liana or with canes up to 7' tall. Leadlets 5 to 7, rugose, but not as in R. rugosa. Fruits (hips) red, much smaller than in rugosa, about 5 mm in diam, in combs. Multiflora? escaped?
