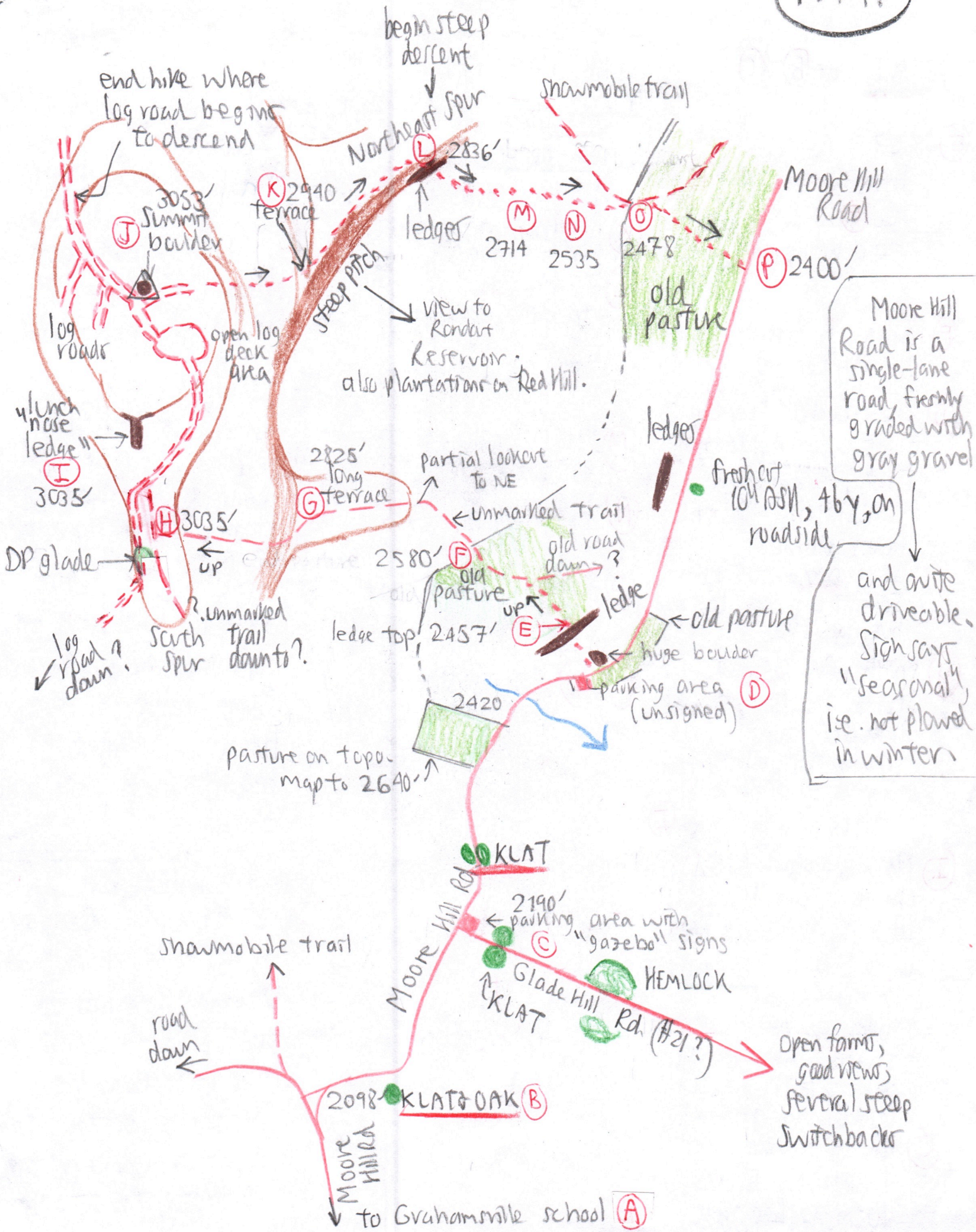

(L) 2836'. OAK & BC, 80 to 100y, estimate, plus much young B. Few SUB.

(M) 2714'. Soils moisten SUB dom + PA

(N) highest ASH - 2535' with more below.

(O) native e-white pret Vacc ang in old fields.

(P to D) 10^M Ash stump at roadside is 4by ✓ #2

Then sale to SNY(?) but recent hiker map shows still Summit as private. No blazer or posted signs obs.

Sale to SNY on E shoulder must have been long ago enough that all stumps have rotten, but summit might recently have been sold.

(E) 2457'. Old pasture from top of ledge (E) to (F) 2580': PB & e white pine (not planted) pioneers

(F) 2580'. Pasture ends. Older trees, but 2°.

(G) 2825' Lookout (winter) to NE = Red Mill tower, Table, Peekamoquet Slide Mtns. DP + LL BC & B dom.

Some OAK & SUB & PB. Some trees may be 100y but not 10.

(H) south spur. OAK BC Stump ca- 15 to 20y old. Bark off, top of stump still flat. 6-year old BC on skid road just below (I)

(I) Narrow "nose ledge" -- the only summit ledge obs. 10' high, 20' wide, open with 2 mature SORBUS on top. Lush.

SUB - OAK - BC - B - RM twisted but 50' tall. \$int, Epitaphy DP Monotropa \$camyl.

(J) Ox on summit with 1 KAMAM. Boulder 10' high. Log deck
