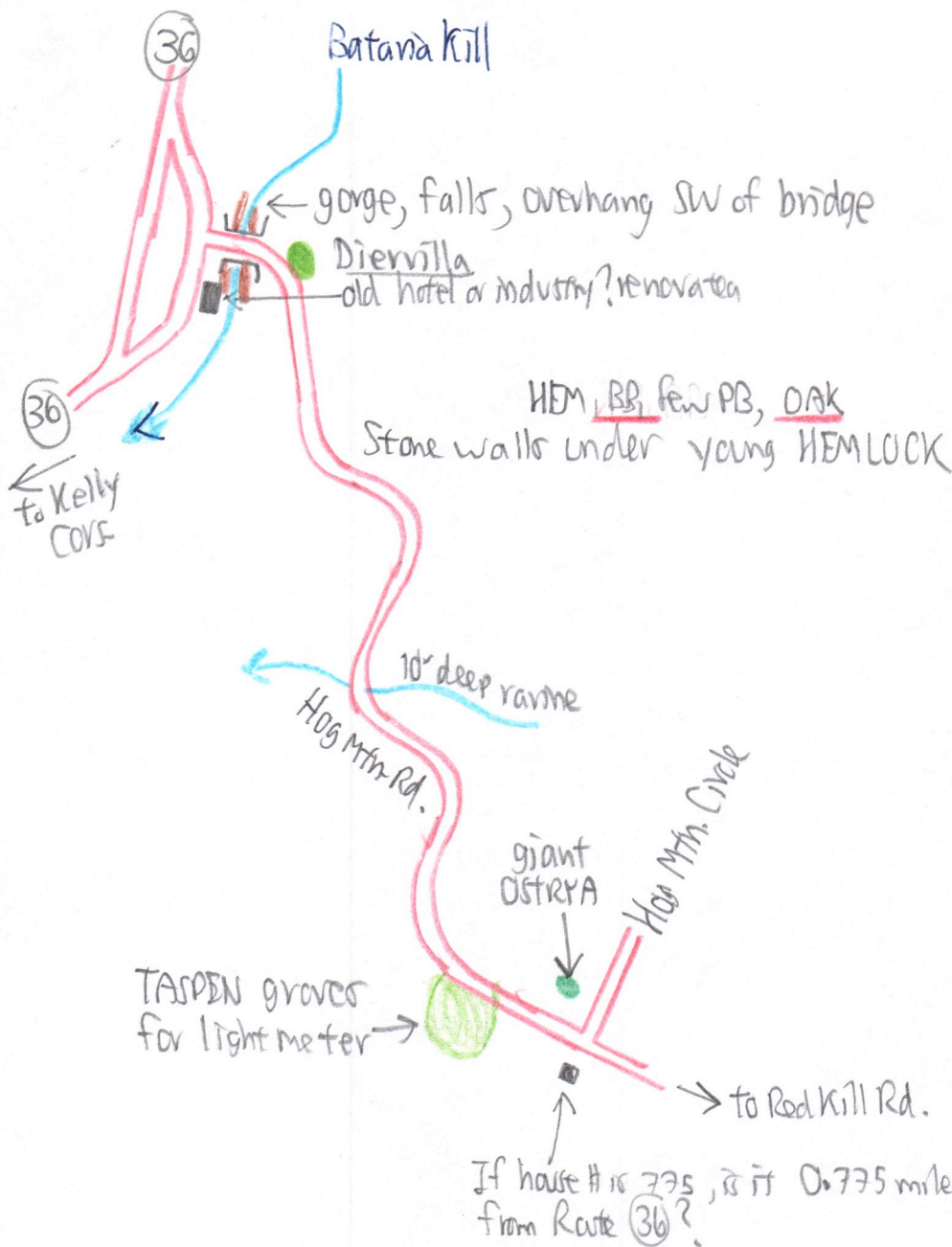

Prolific & fresh road cuts in till,
 about 20% rock, locally $\pm 25\%$,
 very silty. Few boulders on forest
 floor. Humus $\ll 1"$ thick. Is
 humus destroyed by pasturization
 (not Pasteurization) and requires
 centuries to rebuild? **Kes**
