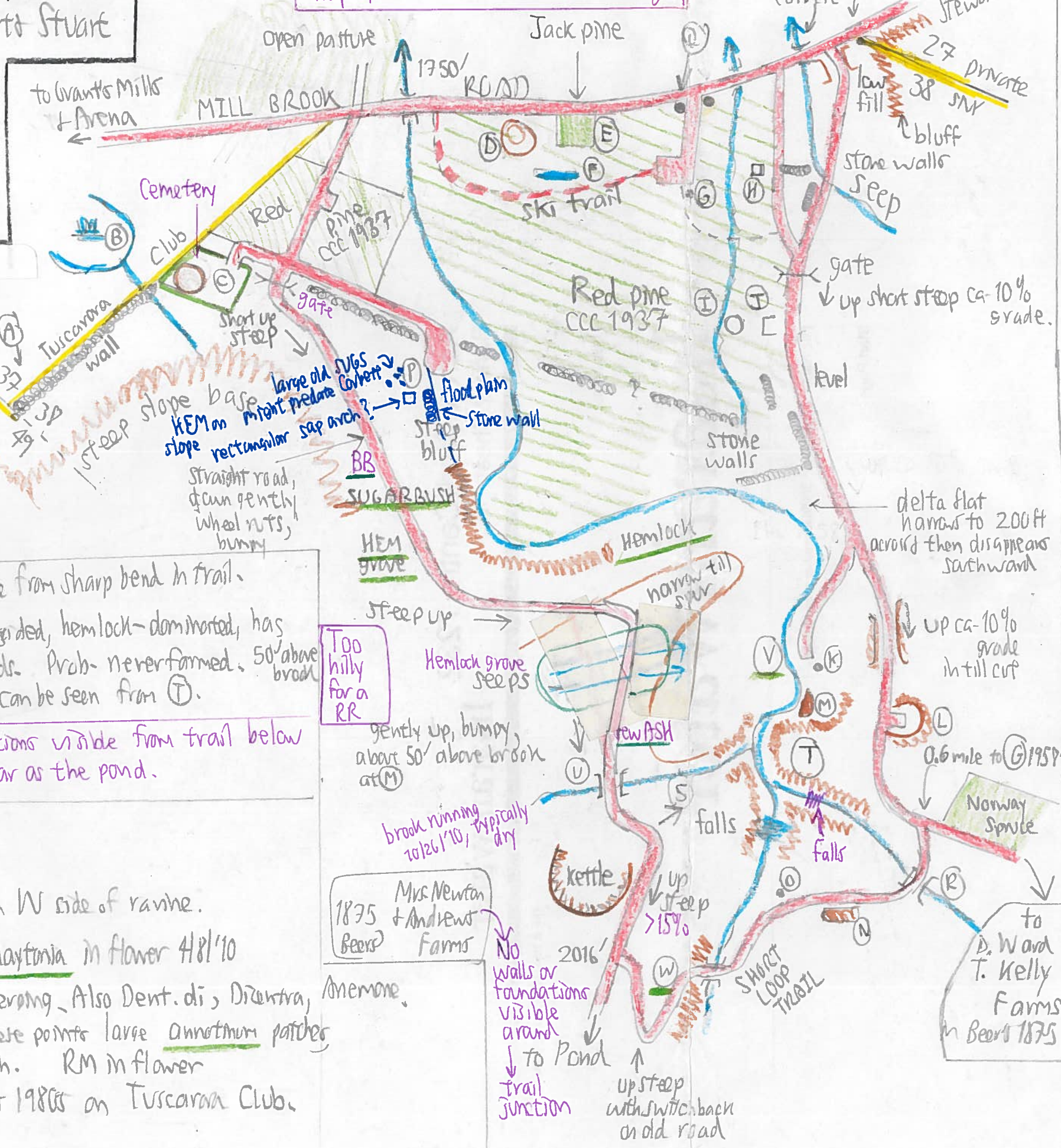

## Legend

- (A) Corner of 4 lots. #48 SNY before 1899. #38 & 49 acquired 1930s. #37 private Tuscarora Wall ends at corner. Club.
- (B) Beaver meadow = too shallow for peat. Sandbottom Salix, *Spiraea lat*, *Sphagnum*, *Calamagrostis*?
- (C) Cemetery. Gavetts (George & Thomas G.) buried here. Portion of Cemetery on Knoll (Kame?) is older with some gravestones illegible. Others are 1866, 1875, 1879, 1882, 1887 through to 2001. 1883 1884 1892
- (D) No evidence for Schoolhouse #9 shown on Beer's 1869 Map & Margenthale 1904 Quad. The mound here suggests a good spot possibility
- (E) Jack pine planted by CCC 1937 is at beginning of gentle curve on Mill Brook Rd, heading E.
- (F) Drainage ditch parallel to ski trail.
- (G) Trailhead register. 9.9 miles from 2810.
- (H) Cellar. Shows on 1904 M'ville Quadrangle. About 125' E of (G).
- (I) CCC. Cistern or barn silo base? visited 2005 with D. Galusha & F. Manning
- (J) foundation for barn?
- (K) U.S Forest Service KH1 Survey stake. Road ends on flood plain.
- (L) Borrow pit?
- (M) Landslide into brook
- (N) Fragmenting ledge, the only ledge seen all day except falls.
- (O) "Half way" sign
- (P) Campsite
- (Q) DEC sign for Kelly Hollow trails. The westerly entrance road is not marked.
- (R) New bridge, but stone abutments may date to CCC. Bridge here on 1904 M'ville Quad.



- (S) View of confluence from sharp bend in trail.
- (T) Peninsula, steep-sided, hemlock-dominated, has windthrow mounds. Prob. never farmed. 50' above brook
- (U) The bridge at (U) can be seen from (T).

No walls or foundations visible from trail below a site almost as far as the pond.

(V) Older trees on W side of ravine.

(W) Vicia rotundifolia Claytonia in flower 4/8/10  
(A) Ery, Allium leaves emerging. Also Dent. di, Dicentra, Anemone.  
(B) Between these points large Anemone patches Black birch. RM in flower  
Stump 1960s & 1980s on Tuscarora Club.

Tuscarora Club was banned on the east by Corbett Stuart on 3/16/26, in a public notice against hunting & fishing.

In 1926, Corbett Stuart could have owned Lots 44 & 38, but not 39 & 50 which had been acquired by SNY in 1925.

Don't look in for plantations for a RR grade!! There wouldn't have been enough time betw. pasture abandonment arrival of Corbett & Stuart for trees

CC plantations prob 1937 (Galusha p. 141-142) on Corbett-Johnson farm. See Stead 1869 Del Co Atlas for location of Corbetts.
