More info.:

(C) Hemlock sapling part way up ledge, 3435'. There is a hemlock population at the 1st ledge ca 3700' just above the monument, but only individual saplings like this above.

(E) Wet spot is small on trail at junc. spur path to S lookout
 VCASS on trail. PB-SORB-PIN disclimax at lookout.
NO NEMO. Not much VCASS; it may have been partly shaded at since 1970.

Bog # 312 is fragmented & overgrown with fir. Wet spots separated. Open areas almost non-existent. Bypassed without obs. on 6/10/11 hike. Streptopus amplex partly
 Just below to N of trail is a 24" PB, the largest tree around for a long distance. browed.

Sorbus leaves are 10" to 12" long.

On summit, a group of roundabout campers from Lake Delaware (Gerry Estate); Borina was met.

High Falls Brook Ridge has 2 patches of dead SUBT from the defoliation, viewed from Slide Mtn. lookouts.
 at ca. 4100'

Firs on N lookout vary greatly in color: glaucous blue to green.

(I) Pebbly soils begins at the Knob & continues to summit, (as Congelifracta, perhaps from Conglomerate, instead of till?)
