(C) to (E) + (EE): SUB-BEECH dominated forest. MO + YB young pole stands suggest last logging was in the 1990s, not late 1970s, as John Wadlin

(F) suggested.

Near (E) ASH are locally common & about 10" to 12" dbh, suggesting a logging here in the 1960s. An older stump around (EE) confirms this.

The knoll above W of (I) confluence is flat on top at about the same elev. as the stream terraces at (K) + (P). Maybe the knoll also marks the level of a former Esopus Creek level about 25' to 30' above the present?

The Esopus headwaters S of (N) are much higher in elev. than the nearby W. Br. Neversink at (W) suggesting that the Esopus is much newer to the area.

Is a stream capture imminent? Patrick does not know the bedrock depth under his house, but it's > 15 feet of till on top.

(L) to (M). Looks 1st growth on the bouldery steep slope above Chris Cabin. Only one stump, close to the road & YB bark still on. Many large old hemlocks, the biggest 39.3" dbh & maybe 250y? YBs old, too, but dbhs around 24" to 30" ±. Not much else on this slope: some Ilex mont. One small SUB & one RM ca 20". Our route up brought us to the South side of Y-C-Ruby and we missed the ledges supporting it.

Chris & his brother had made a trail in their youth, with some can covers still up.

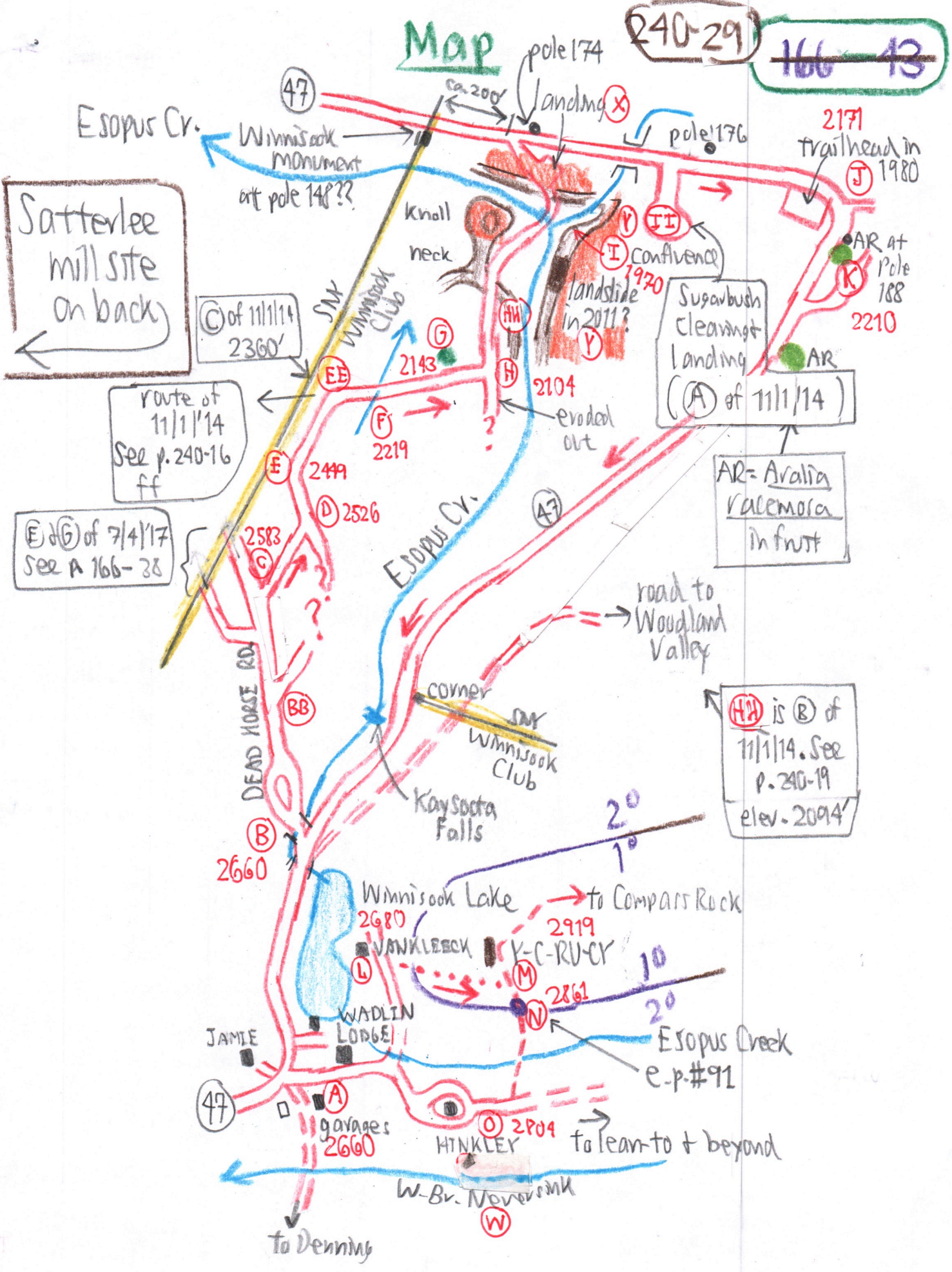

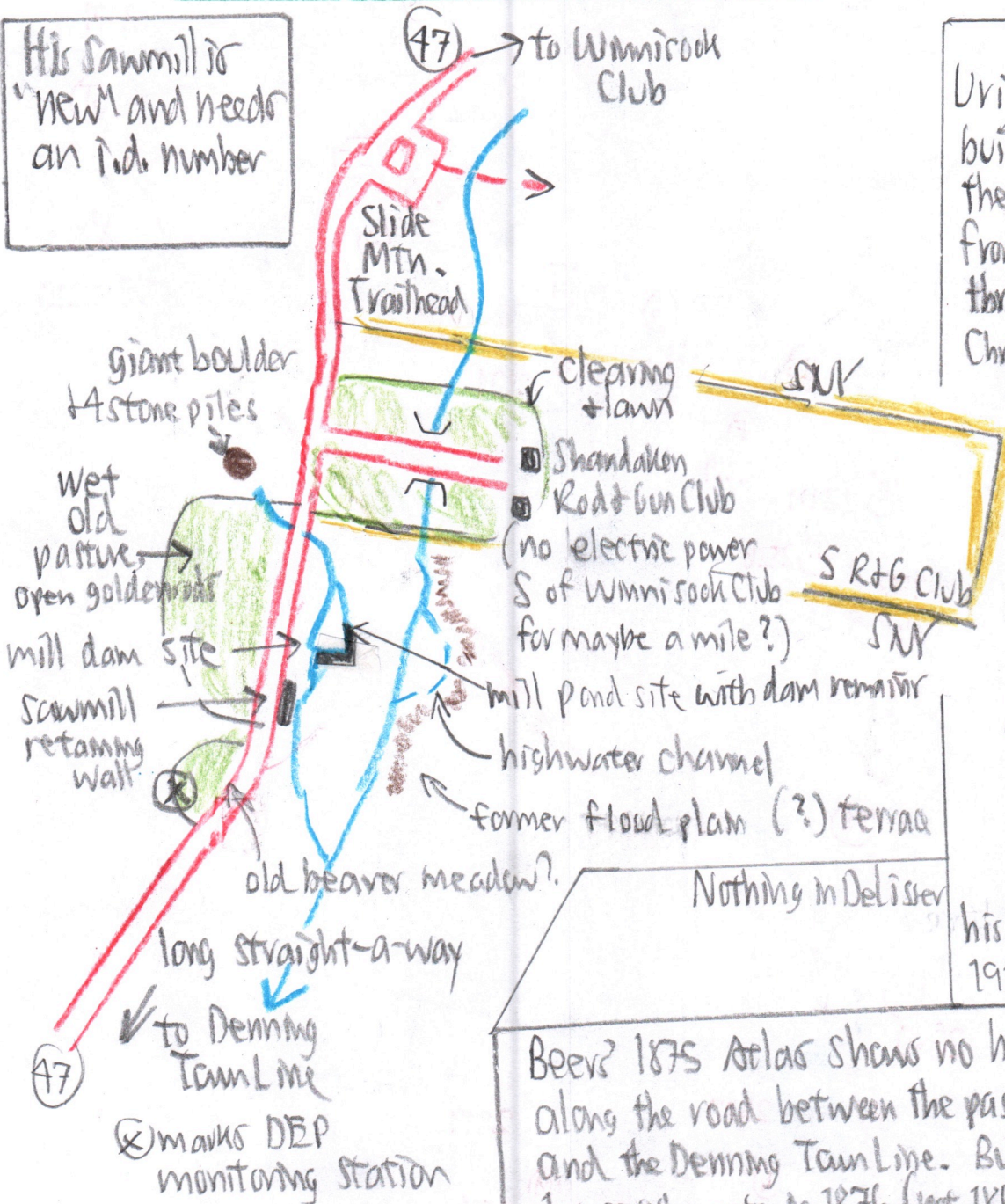
Uriah Satterlee's Mill

His Sawmill is "New" and needs an I.D. number

Uriah Satterlee built cabins for the Winnisook Club from 1887 (The Lodge) through 1900 to 1912. Chris' Cabin is 1908-

Chris reports that one Club member hiked the road south and found in 1920s, the Satterlee buildings still standing but abandoned. Therefore Uriah abandoned his farm ca-1915 or 1920. MK has now the report.



Beers' 1875 Atlas shows no houses or farms along the road between the pass (now Winnisook Lake) and the Denning Tann Line. Burroughs describes 1st settlements in 1876 (not 1869) but may be in Denning. ^{Winnisook} Satterlee ^{only} at Front Valley in 1875. Does ^{Uriah} 1900 Slide Mtn. Quad. show location of Satterlee farm + mill? Yes! * What does DeLisser say? Nothing.

Shandaken Rod + Gun Club bought the ^{Uriah} Satterlee tract + later sold SW part to SNY. When? Which Satterlee also sold to Forstmann? ^{Winnisook} Wm-G?

* Mill is shown with elev. 2409. House on NW side of road, 1/4 mile below mill and 3/8 mile above Tann Line.

Deer Park: Bordered on Tann Line? Yes. See p. 167-12. Where did MK find the old fence? See MK notes p. 167-12. Fence was below, mid-straightaway.
