Michael Hough, SUNY Cortland, kept a list of ca-200 spp. from AM walk to Esopus Creek & PM walk around Winne Farm and up the hill to the east. This list should appear in Fall NYFA newsletter. Here are some MK highlights:

Trees & Shrubs

Fraxinus pennsylvanica has a softer, scaly bark than F. americana

(I-D questionable at S end of Winne Farm loop trail). Also use leaf scar top shape

K-lar. at uppermost trail switchback - one plant.

Quercus prinus common along trail up hill with one big Q. alba N of trail end on top near a big stone pile

Cephalanthus sapling near Esopus Cr. bench area, mostly with opp. lvs, not whorled. Lvs. like Cornus with arcuate venation

Vitis labrusca, not V. riparia, with large fruit at small bridge on entrance road

Fems: Phegopteris hexagonoptera, maybe not P. connectilis on hillside trail

Dicot Herbs:

Circaea lutetiana → canadensis may also be at 2810 & I-D as C. quadrisulcata. Check.

Loebelia cardinalis in ditch ^{W of} Winne Farm Loop

Hackelia ^{seedling} looks like Smilax rotundifolia, but older plant has different lvs. At SW cor. Winne Farm Trail. Boraginaceae

Geranium sibiricum

Polygonum (Tovara) virginianum

Hieracium paniculatum

Monocots:-
Carex appalachica looks like C. bromoides
Luzula multiflora
