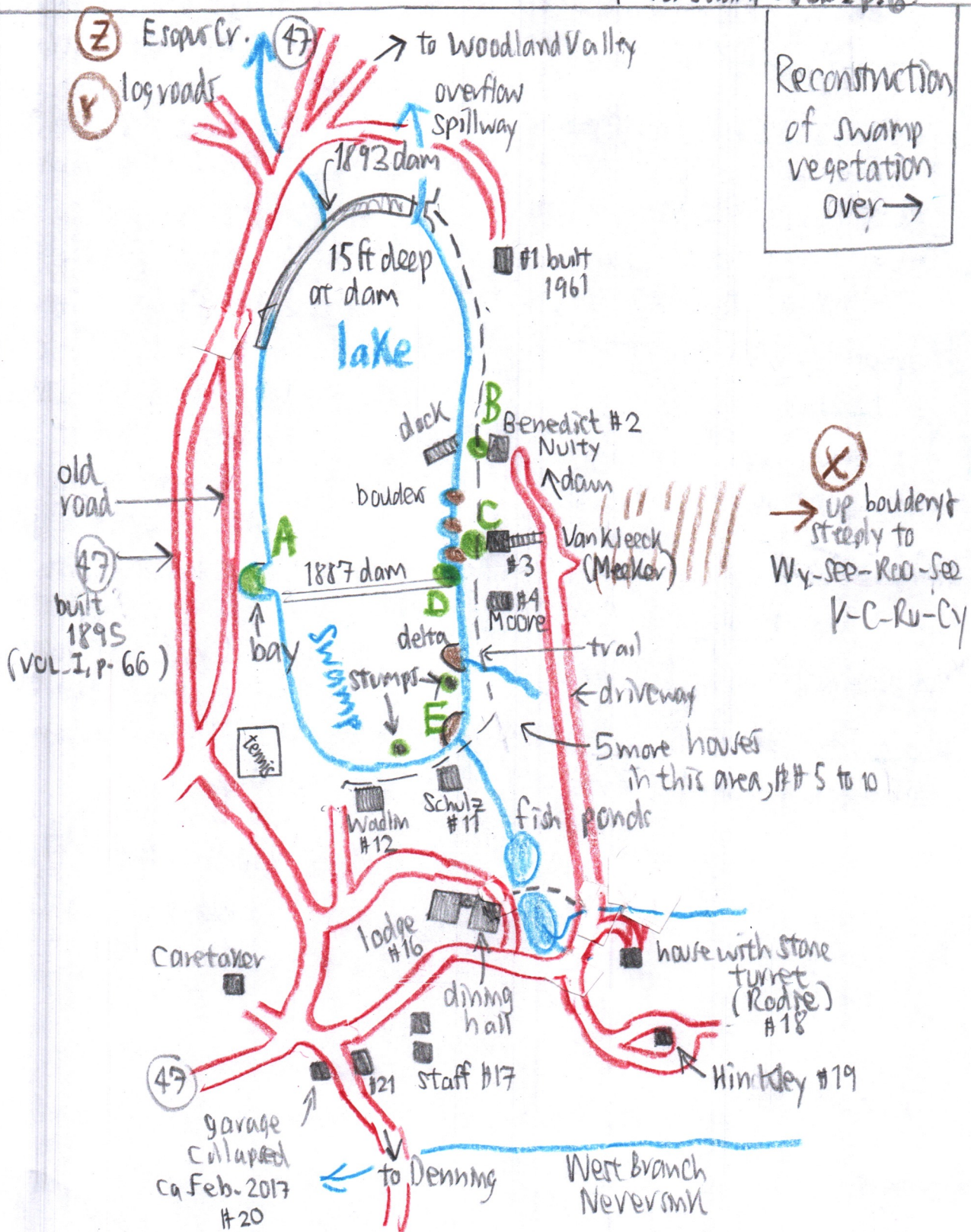

Reconstruction of Swamp vegetation

- A in small bay, a swamp remnant with CENN hummock & Onoclea & Ilex vert.
- B Lone red spruce 8' tall (estab. ca. 1977) x 2 1/2" diameter at base, NOT planted. Growing at 2 1/2" ±/year. Age 40.
- C Several frs around Chris' cabin, from saplings to 6" x ±30'. Native.
- D Small bay with Myosotis scorpioides & NEMO
- E Stumps, wood coll. from 2 & both Y.B. Predate 1887 flooding.

Common around lake edge & could have been in swamp: KENLUCK, R.M., SALEA

Yew common around the lake!

Rhodo. max. - planted. Closest native station is Bog #350 in E Br Nev.

To-do next

- Z Chris reports a falls on the Esopus
- Y follow log road to end, almost on contour.
- X Climb slope above Chris' Cabin to look for 1°. Old PBTIEM around the cabin
- E Core the shallow water at S end of lake. The brooks have created sandy-gravelly deltas 1" to 2" thick, locally up to 8" or 9", since 1887. See if there is peat buried under the sand bottom. Bring shovel & Eijkolkamp and wade at into shallow lake in summer. Chris says water was only a few feet deep at the old 1887 dam. All swimming is below it. The swamp may have been south of the 1887 dam only. Below that, a forested stream to the north.

More history

1. Chris asked if MK found ? Falls downstream on Esopus Check 11/1/14 field notes, p. 240-
2. Chris found remains of Satterlee (?) Sawmill on W Br Nev. somewhere near Denning Town line. Have him locate it on map in field.
3. Vivian says Raymond Riordan School help plant Rochester Hollow Burroughs Memorial ca. 1923, years before C-C-C could have.

Winnisook Lake Probe

south shore and west shore from swamp remnant 1/2 way to dam back to tennis court

Using 6 ft probe rod & shovel.

Swamp pre-dam was a SWAMP, NOT a peatland. Lake bottom is mineral, with textures ranging from silt up to 5" or 6" deep (creating clouds in water), to sand, gravel, cobbles & boulders. Probing through silt or sand leads to rock, gravel, or till—NO peat. Eijkolkamp sampler could not get through. Apparently no peat beneath.

Water surprisingly warm ^{at SE corner} 76°, 77°, 80°F + acids.

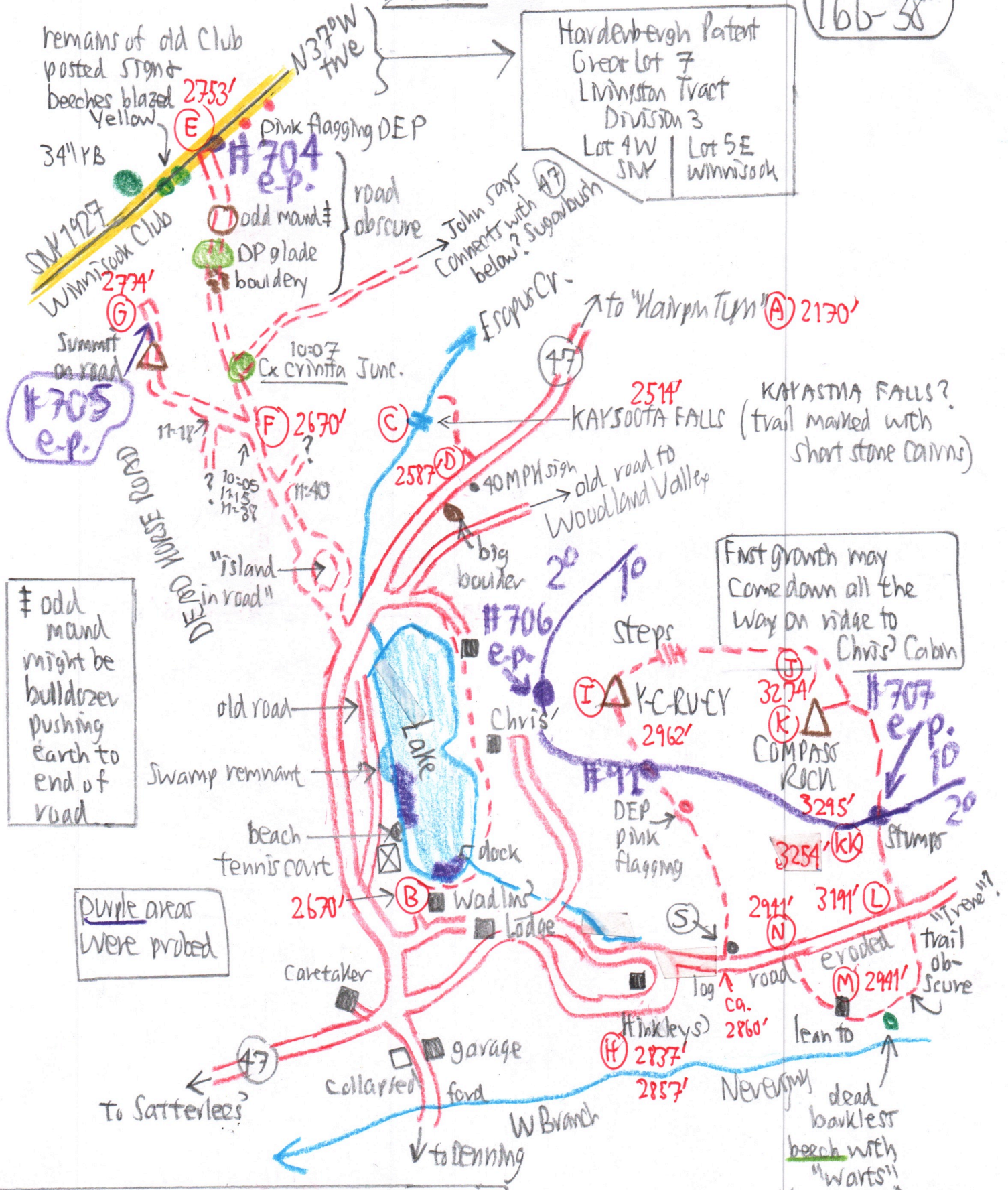

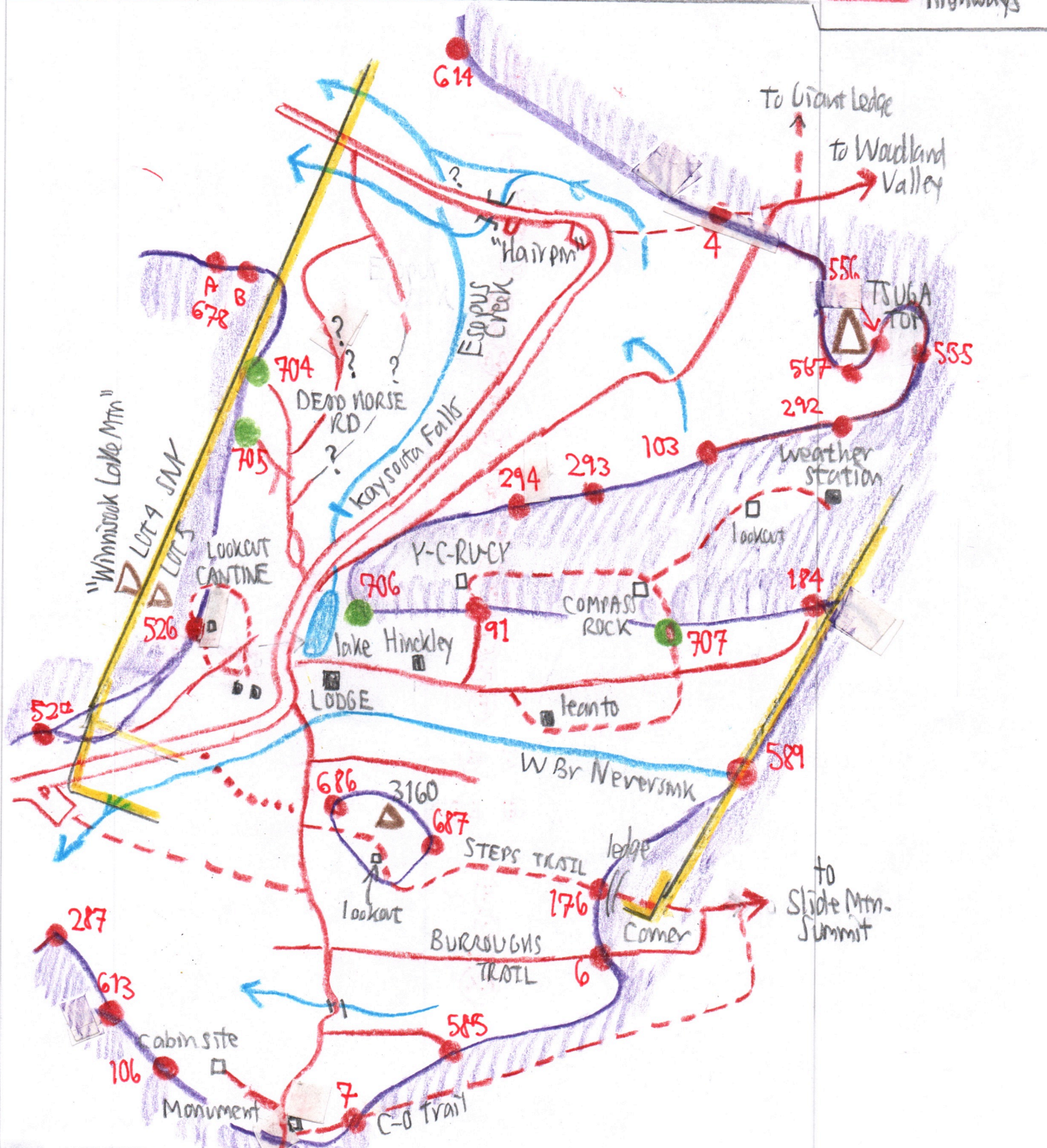
