WALK ONLY ON THE ROCKS, preferably on the trail. Please do not walk through the alpine meadows or on any other plants.

PLEASE DO NOT PICK ANY PLANTS OR FLOWERS. Many plants at this elevation are endangered species and are protected by law.

LEASH YOUR DOGS and keep them from walking on the tundra plants.



Please save the plants by walking only on the rocks!
